Identify the stated main idea in a reading selection. Identify nouns. Identify proper and common nouns. Identify singular nouns. Use a dictionary to revise the spelling, pronunciation, and meaning of words. Write words in alphabetical order using first and second letter criteria.
Unit 2. Discovering Landforms	 Identify short and long vowels in words. Define fiction. Define nonfiction. Identify cause and effect relationship. Use the regular present tense of verbs. Use action verbs. Use action verbs. Use the verb to be in present and past tense. Use dictionary skills. Identify complete sentences. Identify fragments. Correct fragments to form complete sentences.
Unit 3. Fascinating Myths	 Identify the structure and elements of a myth. Identify the story elements in a text. Use verbs in sentences. Identify the regular past tense of verbs. Identify the irregular past tense of verbs. Identify types of sentences. Write different types of sentences.
	• Use correct punctuation for each type of sentence.

Unit 4. The Magic of Poetry	 Distinguish between short and long vowel sounds in poems. Use tongue twisters for identifying initial sounds in words. Establish differences between poetry, fiction, and nonfiction. Identify and distinguish rhythm in poems. Create rhythm in poems by using repetition. Identify the structure of a poem.
Unit 5. Heroes We Admire	 Define the concept biography. Identify the characteristics of a biography. Identify the parts of a sentence. Recognize the noun as part of a subject. Recognize the verb as part of a predicate. Use subject pronouns to substitute nouns in a sentence.
Unit 6. What About The Arts	 Discriminate and identify the ei, ey, ew, ie, and igh sounds in words. Identify adjectives. Use descriptive adjectives in sentences including shapes, colors, and sizes. Identify demonstrative adjectives. Write sentences using descriptive adjectives about an art piece.
Unit 7. How Important Is Weather?	 Discriminate and identify the silent letter in kn, gn, and wr. Decode words with the silent letter kn, gn, and wr. Identify main idea and supporting details. Use commas in sentences. Use definite and indefinite articles in sentences. Write sentences that use commas. Write sentences with indefinite articles.
Unit 8. Taking Care of The Environment	 Discriminate and identify the R-controlled vowels. Decode words with the R-controlled vowels. Identify sequence of events. Use context clues to identify the meaning of unknown words.

Unit 9. Legends Through Tim	 Discriminate and identify R-controlled vowels. Decode words with R-controlled vowels. Define realistic fiction. Identify the elements of realistic fiction. Identify author's purpose. Use prepositions. Write sentences using prepositional phrases.
Unit 10. Tales to Remember	 Discriminate and identify the hard and soft C in words. Decode words with hard and soft C. Discriminate and identify the hard and soft G in words. Decode words with hard and soft G. Define fantasy. Identify the elements of fantasy. Compare fantasy with realistic fiction. Identify interjections in sentences. Use adverbs.


